on behalf of Pennsylvania local municipalities in the landmark case <u>Robinson Township vs.</u>
 <u>Commonwealth.</u> As a result, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court found several provisions of Act 13, the
Pennsylvania Oil and Gas Act of 2012, unconstitutional, returning zoning rights back to the peoples'
respective local governments.
